**Notes**

John M. Coyle of Saginaw City, Ohio, purchased from William Cox and wife recorded the 31st of March 1846, for a hundred dollars; Seventeen plus 25 one hundredths of an acre located in section 34 in the Township of St. Clair.

In the 1840 census, John Coyle between the age of 20-30 and Mary between the age of 20-30 along with one female under five and one male under five were found in the Montgomery County, New York census on pg. 127 line 30.

According to the 1870 census, John Coyle was a farmer, value of property \$2,000.00 and personal property \$300.00. He was a U. S. citizen. He could not read or write.

According to the 1900 census, the father (John) and mother of Elizabeth were both born in Ireland.

According to "St. Clair County Michigan its History and its People" by William Lee Jenks, Volume II, Published by The Lewis Publishing Company, Chicago and New York, 1912, John Coyle came to Michigan in 1854 from New York.

A death notice in the St Clair Republican dated 8 of March 1870 is as follows:

Death of Capt. John Coyle. We chronicle the death, on the 23d uit., of Capt. John Coyle, an old, respected and prominent citizen of this county, at his residence in St. Clair township.

Obituary: Mrs. Estes Trumble.

Mrs. Estes Trumble, nee Elizabeth Coyle, died Saturday of influenza.

The deceased was born Aug. 26, 1844 in New York state and came with her parents, Mr and Mrs. John Coyle to St. Clair in 1854.

In November 1865 she was married to Estes Trumble a native of New York state, but then a resident of St. Clair town. To them were born nine children. Of these William died April 6, 1902; Edward, April 29, 1902 and Wallace, on December 2, 1913 while James, Lewis, Estes, Fred, Lottie now Mrs. Simons, and Milton are living and well known to our people. There with her husband and a brother Hugh Coyle remain to mourn her loss.

The deceased was a devoted mother and a woman of amiable disposition who was highly esteemed by all who knew her.

The funeral was held from the M. E. church in this city Monday and was conducted by Rev. Samuel Jennings. The interment was in the Hillside cemetery.

The funeral of the late Mrs. Estes Trumble was held on Tuesday of last week, and the remains were interred in the Hillside cemetery. Rev. Samuel Jennings officiating Mrs. Trumble was 70 years of age and had resided on the Marsh road, near this city, for a great many years. She was well known among the older residents of the city, and was highly respected by all who knew her. Besides a husband she is survived by one daughter and four sons.
