Coach Hirshey started new regulars this year because of the loss of Seniors the year before. All in all it was a very good season.

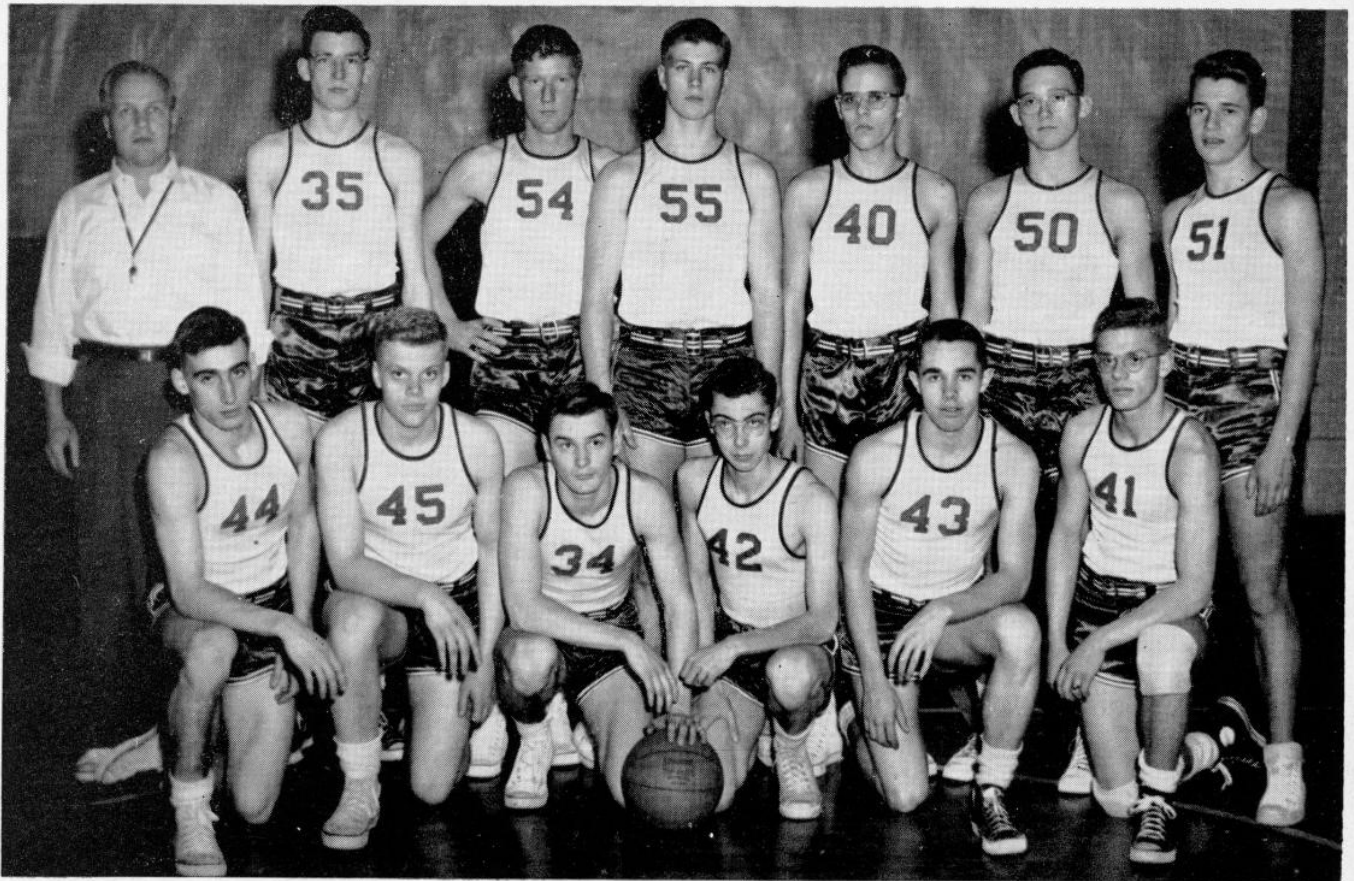

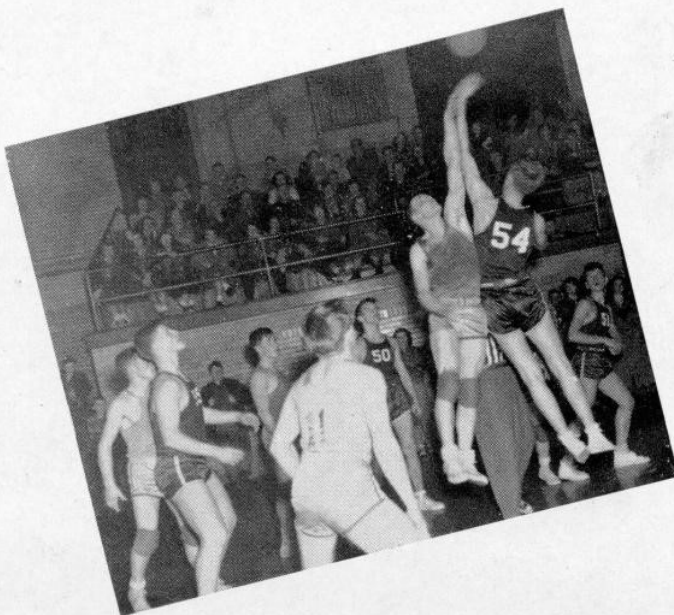
